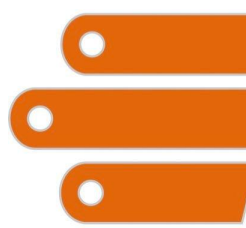
Percussion Practice Schedule Change

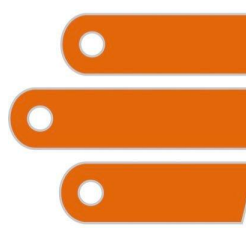
Fair Performance
