#### Symphonic Band

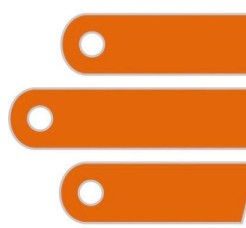
- Up on a Housetop - 40 to 57 (notes/rhythms; style and articulation.)

- Joy - 28 (Notes/rhythms; style/dynamics)
