- Safely Rest - 63 to End - (style; intonation; making a connection)

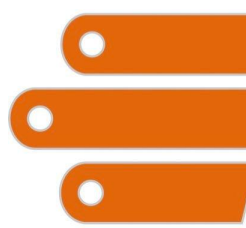
Concert Band

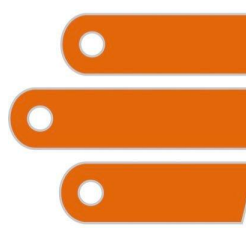
All City Band Concert
