- Joy - 28 to 55 (notes/rhythms;style/articulation; transitions)

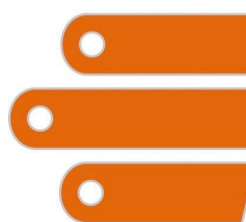
Jazz Band/Combo
