

#### **Practices on School Days**

I want to remind everyone that you need to have everything for after school practices when you come to school. We've had several students forget certain items and it makes practice that much harder. Please plan accordingly.

Students should bring to school with them:

- Athletic shoes/athletic socks

- Water Bottle (we will have our water jugs to fill them)

To help with this cost, we are opening the trip up to those students who aren't in marching band, but are a part of the band program at Hayes.
