JULY 4 PARADE

The July 4 parade will be this Tomorrow. Students need to report to the HS at 10a dressed in the Summer Uniform. (Orange Shirt - Band; Gray Shirt - Guard; Black Shorts; Tennis Shoes) From the HS we will walk to the Fair Grounds where the parade starts at 11a. This is a change in time from what I originally posted. The parade will travel down Sandusky street where the parade will finish at the Hardware Exchange. Students can be picked up in the parking lot of Selby Stadium/St. Mary's parking lot on South Henry St. The parade should last approximately an hour. Students are encouraged to take instruments home after the parade. However, any percussion/tuba students are responsible for getting their equipment back to the HS after the parade. The HS will be open immediately after the conclusion of the parade till 1p.

In the case of inclement weather, please look for an email/text from section leaders regarding the parade. **UNLESS YOU RECEIVE AN EMAIL/TEXT THE PARADE IS STILL HAPPENING.**

PRE/BAND/POST CAMP

Band camp starts on July 22 from 9a to 3p. These dates are mandatory for attendance. We will be spending these 3 weeks learning the bulk of our competition show, as well as learning pre-game and other requirements for the season. Please make sure you are preparing in advance so we can have the most successful camp as possible. Below is a list of required items:

- Instrument/Music Folder (3-ringed binder w/page protectors)
- Pencil
- Large Water Bottle (32oz)
- Packed Lunch (Cadence Club will provide dinners only during Band Camp Week)
 - NO ONE IS PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE HS FOR LUNCH!!!
 - IT IS NOT RECOMMENDED TO ORDER FOOD TO BE DELIVERED. LUNCH MAY NOT BE AT THE SAME TIME EACH DAY. YOU WILL NOT BE DISMISSED TO ORDER/PICK UP FOOD WHEN REHEARSING.
 - Plan to pack HEALTHY. Extra Sugar, Caffeine, and junk food will only make you feel sick. We need everyone feeling good/healthy.
- Athletic Shoes - We will be outside moving A LOT. Please make sure to keep your feet comfortable. Running Shoes are the best option here!
- Wear comfortable clothing that you can move freely in. We will also be outside the majority of the day. Please **DO NOT** wear long pants/shirts, sweatshirts, etc. when it's 80+ degrees outside. If you are cold in the morning, please wear layers to ensure you're not overheating in the afternoon. If you DO NOT dress appropriately for rehearsal, we will provide attire for you. We had too many students overheating last year due to wearing the wrong attire.
- Sun Protection - Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Hats are all encouraged during rehearsals. Please note that once we go inside, sunglasses should be taken off!

Pictures will be taken from 1p - 3p. We will rehearse in the morning, so please be mindful of attire that day. Students will still have the opportunity to eat lunch and get ready for pictures after rehearsal.

The reason for the earlier date is so Senior Banners can be ready for Pacerfest. Seniors should come already dressed to change into their Full Uniform. - Third installment (\$25) due 8/7

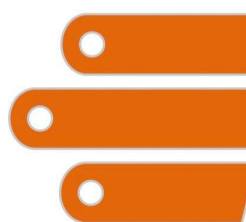
Marching Band Food Fee: \$35 (please make checks payable to Cadence Club)

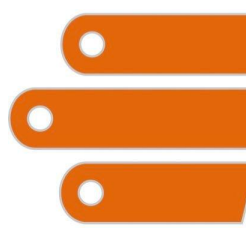
