After School Rehearsals Week of 9/16

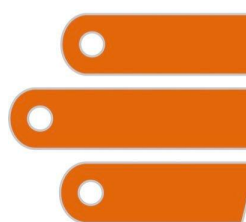
ALL STUDENTS are required to be at these rehearsals. The schedule for weekly rehearsals are as follows:

Please only use the paper that is provided. This helps us to keep things uniform and this is what we have permission to hang on the walls.

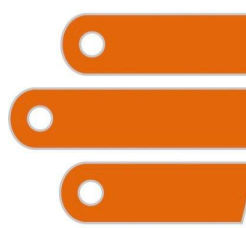

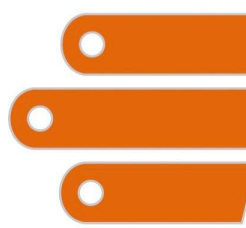
