Buckeye Invitational Information

- Buckeye Invitational Ticket Information Cost & Purchase Location:

The tickets for the Buckeye Invitational will be sold online at <u>go.osu.edu/Bl2024</u> until October 10th or at Ohio Stadium at GATE 5 (on the Northwest side of the Stadium). The cost will be \$20.00 online and \$25.00 at the gate (Credit Card or Cash – EXACT CHANGE ONLY). Kids 6 & under are free and parking is included in the ticket price. Ohio Stadium A, B, & C Decks will be open on the west (press box) side of the stadium for all spectators and all seating is general admission for bands and the public. Students and fans may exit and re-enter Ohio Stadium at any time. Please retain ticket stub for re-entry. *Enclosed is a posting with ticket information, which you may duplicate as needed.

- Concessions:

Concession stands on the west (press box) side of the stadium will be open throughout the day.

Concessions in Ohio Stadium are now cashless. No cash will be accepted at any stand. Personal food and beverage are not permitted inside Ohio Stadium. Please keep this in mind when planning for the day!

October 11 Academic Option Rehearsal/Dempsey Night

We will be having a morning rehearsal on the FB field during Academic Option Friday Morning. Students should report to school as if it were a normal day (M - Th). This is a required rehearsal for ALL Marching Band students. Rehearsal will be from 7:25a - 8:30a. Because that evening is Dempsey Night, we will not have a chance to practice our competition show before Saturday's competitions. This rehearsal will be our last opportunity to prepare.

After School, we will be rehearsing with Dempsey to prepare for our halftime performance. We may also do a run of the show at that time. This is a special evening where we encourage the next generation of Marching Band members. We will feed all band students that evening before the game.
