MARCHING BAND POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

1. ALL REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES ARE MANDATORY

- All anticipated absences must be reported to Mr. Fowles with at least ONE WEEK'S notice via email α. with "Absence" marked in the subject line.
- 2. PLEASE BE PUNCTUAL TO ALL REHEARSALS
 - Showing up to rehearsal at the scheduled time will be considered late. α.
- 3. TREAT ALL MEMBERS, STAFF, CHAPERONES, AND ANYONE ELSE WITH RESPECT
- 4. ALL BEHAVIOR SHOULD BE CONDUCTED AT THE HIGHEST STANDARD

MARCHING BAND POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES:

- 1. Records will be kept concerning all violations of the rules in this handbook. Discipline includes the following:
 - a. Verbal warnings
 - b. Extra-duty assignments from the directors
 - c. Loss of 3rd quarter privileges
 - d. Removal from performance
 - e. Expulsion from the ensemble

MARCHING BAND PRACTICE/PERFORMANCE ATTIRE

PRACTICE ATTIRE:

- CLOSED-TOED ATHLETIC SHOES (Running Shoes)
 - No Boots, Crocs, Slides, etc.
- CLOTHING MUST BE SUITABLE FOR ATHLETIC MOVEMENT
 - Pay attention to the weather! (i.e. wearing black hooded sweatshirts when it's 80 degrees)
- WEAR CUSHIONED ANKLE SOCKS
 - This is to avoid blisters!

Once school starts, please make sure to have your clothes with you.

There will be time to change before rehearsal.

PERFORMANCES:

- 1. SUMMER UNIFORMS
 - a. Orange (Band) / Gray (Guard) Pacer Band Polo
 - b. Black Athletic Shorts
 - c. White Socks
 - d. Athletic Shoes

2. FULL UNIFORM

- a. Orange Compression Shirt
- b. No Bulky Pants/Shorts
- c. Black Calf-High Socks
- d. Clean Black Marching Band Shoes



MARCHING BAND ATTIRE DO's/DON'Ts

- I. The following criteria have been established for achieving a clean and uniform look in our band:
 - a. <u>No Jewelry</u> is to be worn while in uniform
 - i. You may cover piercings with a band aid if they are unable to be removed.
 - ii. Any gauges must be clear.
 - iii. All facial piercings must be removed.
 - b. No nail polish is to be worn in uniform
 - c. Hair must but pulled back and up into the shako
 - i. For longer hair a bun/French braid works best.
 - d. <u>No Hair Dye</u> This can ruin the Shakos as well as bleed onto the uniforms.
 - e. No hair may touch the collar of the uniform
 - f. Uniform pants must be worn as instructed
 - g. Shoes should be polished prior to performance
 - h. Horn should be polished prior to performance


